PROFILE

The vineyard planted at Quinta da Bacalhôa enjoys the ideal terroir for producing outstanding wines—well-drained sandy-loam soils and a mild climate strongly influenced by the Atlantic Ocean. The grape varieties chosen for the estate, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, benefit from natural conditions that promote slow and balanced ripening.

In 2023, both Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon reached harvest with grapes showing ideal ripeness levels and excellent health. Following fermentation of the individual wines under controlled temperatures, a two-week cuvaison (post-fermentation skin maceration) period took place. After a rigorous selection process involving numerous tastings and analyses, the final blend was created and aged in new French oak barrels for 24 months.

TASTING NOTES

Maintaining its classic style, Quinta da Bacalhôa displays prominent aromas of red fruit, combined with subtle notes of oak and spices. On the palate, the red fruit flavors are enhanced and supported by soft yet well-present tannins. The finish is fresh, slightly mineral, elegant, and remarkably complex.

HISTORY

After several centuries of viticulture at Quinta da Bacalhôa — with records dating back to the 15th century — a vineyard was planted in 1974 with two of the world's most renowned French red grape varieties, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. This led to the creation of Portugal's first Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot blend in the 1979 vintage.

Since then, the unique terroir of Quinta da Bacalhôa has enabled the production of a wine that, over 46 vintages released to the market, has consistently displayed elegance and remarkable ageing potential, establishing itself as a true classic among Portuguese wines.
